This FileMaker Pro plug-in provides a bidirectional data exchange between FileMaker Pro and the Apple Calendar application using nothing more than FileMaker script steps. XML programming is not required. Use the iCal Manipulator to eliminate double entry and directly connect FileMaker with Apple Calendar.



## Apple Calendar / Reminders Integration:

Create, retrieve, edit or delete calendars, events and reminders directly in FileMaker. Supports Local, Exchange, IMAP, CalDav, Subscription and Birthday calendar types.



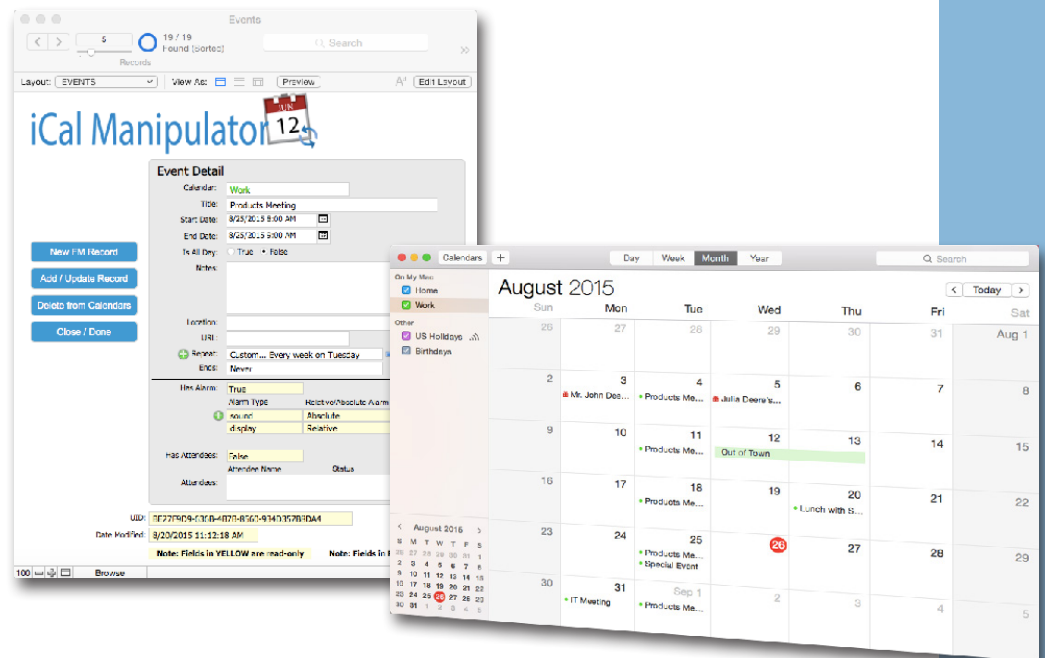
## Repeating Events:

The plug-in includes support for creating, editing, and deleting repeating events in Apple Calendar.



## Mobile Devices:

Push your events and reminders from a FileMaker solution to Apple Calendar allowing users to sync FileMaker data with mobile devices such as a iPhone, Droid, or Blackberry. Since many mobile devices have the ability to sync their native Calendars and Reminders with the Apple Calendar application, you can now use our plug-in to pull your Apple Calendar data into FileMaker and push your FileMaker data into Apple Calendar. This eliminates double entry and allows you to have your calendars and reminders everywhere you like (FileMaker, Apple Calendar, and your mobile device).
